This could be shared by powerpoint, poster, presentation- anything at all, but the children will be talking in class on Monday morning about their family traditions.

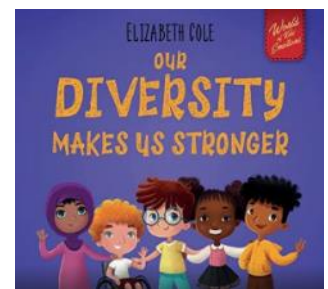

# Do you have concerns about a child's hearing?



Did you know your child is entitled to a free hearing test when they are in reception class?

Below are just a few of the signs that a child may be struggling with their hearing:

- They do not reply when you call them
- They talk very loudly
- They ask you to repeat yourself a lot or respond differently/inappropriately to what you have asked
- They increase the volume on TV/devices etc.
- They appear to daydream a lot
- They are slow to learn to talk/unclear when talking
- They get frustrated/aggressive frequently
