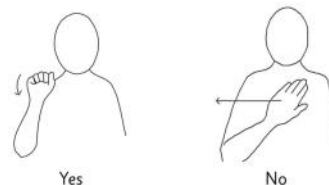

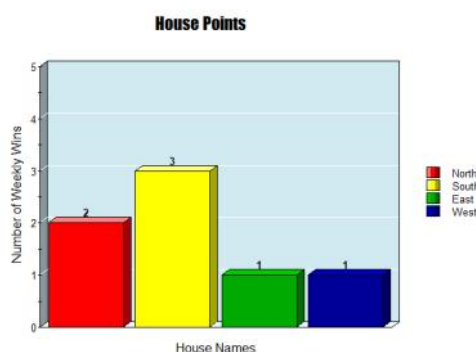

Our School Uniform

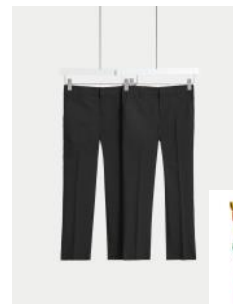

 - White polo shirt or white shirt.

 - Black school shoes
 - Waterproof coat and wellies
