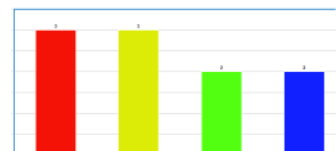

Sports Day and Family Picnic Invitation

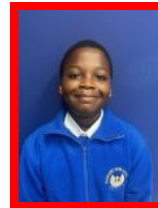
Our House Captains and Mrs Graham, our PE lead, would like to invite you to our annual Sports Day celebration.
