Mrs Kelly and Mrs Baldwin in the office get our award this week.

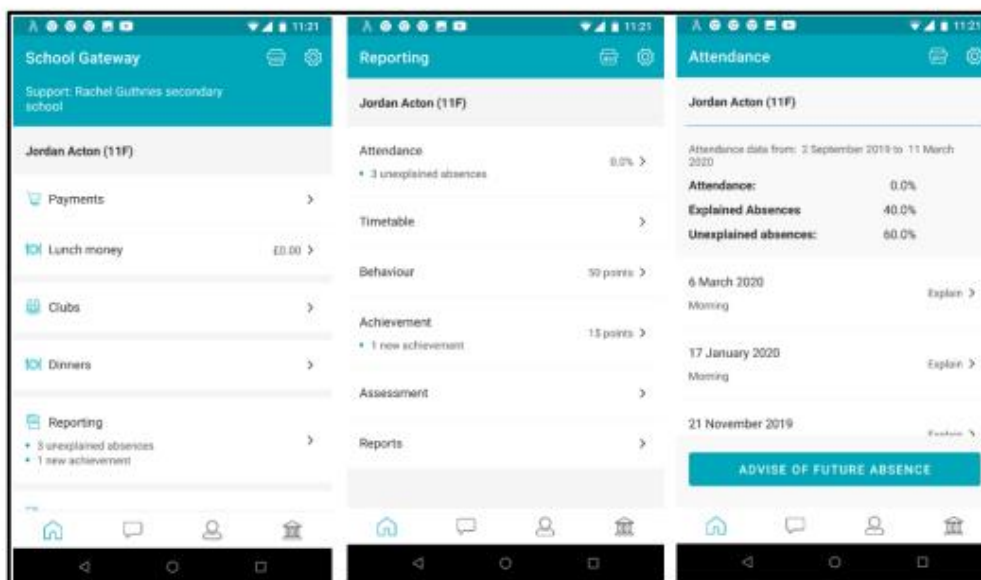
Mrs Kelly because she has been working really hard on our financial year end and Mrs Baldwin because of her positive attitude to everyone.



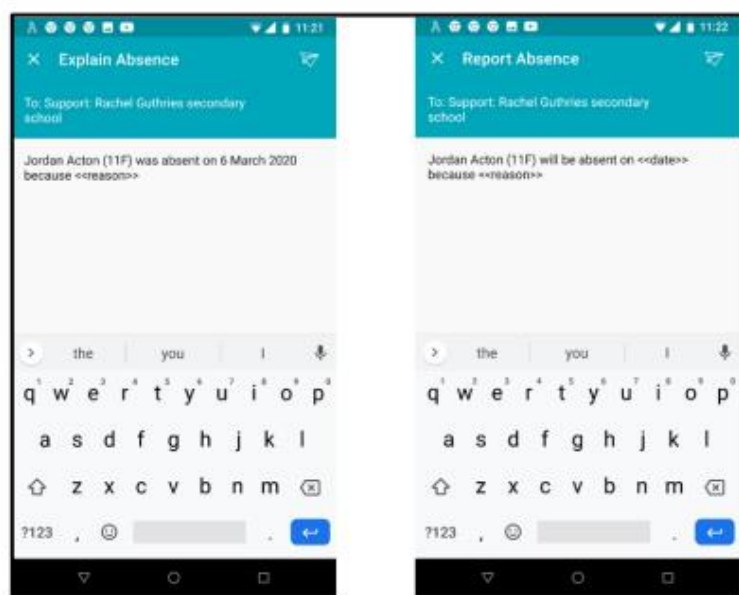


## Reporting an absence on Schoolcomms

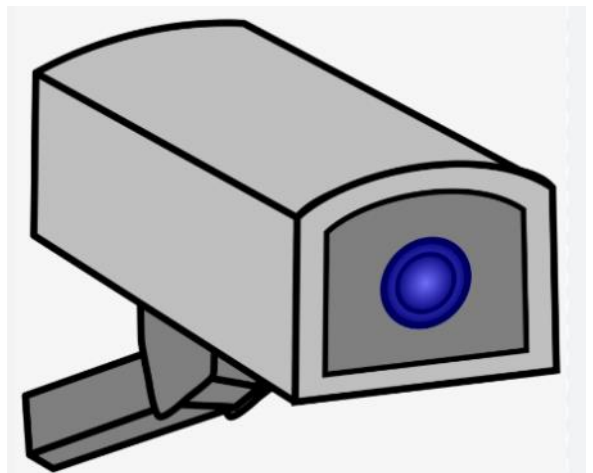
